

Decision/Order of the Commission

Appeal under section 24 of the National Commission for Homoeopathy Act 2020, submitted by Principal, Kent Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Post Khilwat (via-Bidupur Bazar), Hajipur, Dist.- Vaishali, Bihar, vide letter no. KHMCH-51/24 dated 06.09.2024.

Appeal vide letter no. KHMCH-51/24 dated 06.09.2024 from Kent Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Post Khilwat (via-Bidupur Bazar), Hajipur, Dist.- Vaishali, Bihar-843102 has been received by the Commission under section 24 of NCH Act 2020 against the decision of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy.

The MARBH vide letter no. MARBH vide letter no. 4-7/MARBH/NCH/2024-25 (104-14)/4101 dated 23.08.2024 decided to issue denial for continuation of permission in 1st BHMS course with intake capacity of 50 seats, for the academic session 2024-25.

The Commission upon examination of the documents submitted by the college with the appeal, has made the following observations:

I. Observation of Commission:

- From the submitted document that college gave preparatory leave without any tentative duration of leave, issued order on 31.07.2024 however, the order has no issuance reference number thus, authenticity of the order cannot be verified.
- The presence of the Teaching staffs, Guest faculties and Teachers/Consultants of Modern Medicine on the day of visitation could not be verified in absence of attendance register/ biometric attendance register.
- The college has submitted acquaintance roll of teaching staffs from January to July 2024. However, from the available documents it cannot be justified that the college is providing salary through bank as, the college has not submitted its bank statement.
- As per available document availability of 4925 numbers of book is shown however, the available types of books, available authors and available different titles of books could not be verified.
- Department of Pharmacy: It is observed from the attendance register that the presence/absence is not correlating for theory classes for Pharmacy & Physiology. Thus, the maintenance of attendance record seems doubtful.
- Department of Pathology: In absence of any attendance registers of practical session conduction of practical session cannot be justified.

7. All Departments: The available photograph does not justify availability of Practical record/ Journal book of student related to subject as the college has not provided any Practical record/ Journal book of any student.
8. It is observed that the collegiate hospital has 3658 IPD patients and 3656 bed days which signifies that the collegiate hospital is running as a day care hospital wherein patients are admitted for 24 hours or less than that.
9. The available registers such as Lab register, X-ray register, ECG register, and USG register are neither signed by concerned technicians/ specialist nor by Medical Superintendent for authenticity of the reports.
10. Operation Theatre: The college has provided photograph of the OT which does not show functionality. The college has not provided any Fumigation register, sterilization register to verify its functionality. The available OT register is not signed by the Surgeon and Medical Superintendent for authenticity of the conduction of procedures.
11. The centralized IPO register does not have time of admission, IPD case taking is superficial, no pursue note available, no specific diet advised, discharge card has no discharge note.
12. On verification of website on 12.09.2024 at 8:07 pm it is observed that the website is non-functional.
13. It is observed that the college was inspected two times and reports of both inspections are different and contradicts each other, which is a hindrance to take appropriate decision.
14. It is also observed that the college is having working Biometric attendance system, but the college has not yet implemented the AEBAS system of attendance.

Overall observation:

- A. Based on the submission made by Kent Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Post Khilwati (Vile-Bidupur Bazaar), Hajipur, Dist- Vaishali, Bihar on 06.09.2024 the documents have been carefully examined as per the provisions of the MSR, Regulations 2013 and the relevant provisions made there under and it is observed that the college do not comply with the mandatory provisions of MSR regulations 2013 in terms of AEBAS and the submitted documents shows poor maintenance of records in college and hospital.
- B. Now, THEREFORE, the Commission decided to reiterate the decision of MARBH vide letter dated 23.08.2024 as denial for continuation of permission in 1st BHMS course for the session 2024-25.
- II. Accordingly, your representation dated 06.09.2024 to Commission against MARBH letter dated 23.08.2024 stands disposed off.
- III. If aggrieved with the above decision as per NCH Act 2020 may place a second appeal to the Central Government within 7 days of issue of this communication of above decision.

Kent Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital At & P.O. Khilwat (via-Bidapur Bazar) Hajipur, District Vaishali, Bihar has functioned since '01-02 and has applied for permission for sanction of 50 seats in BHMS for the academic year 2023-24. The College has submitted the Part-I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfills the Minimum Essential Standards to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the application, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has observed the following shortcomings as per MRS requirements.

A. Teaching Staff

Form-7 from traces work has not been uploaded for teachers not teaching staff and hospital staff. The college is directed to submit the form-7 from traces portal of entire staff for the last year and statement from the concerned bank of salary distributed through bank for the last 03 months for verification.

B. Hospital facilities

- * No case record sheets are uploaded in Part-I information.
- * Manual and computerized OPI register is not submitted in Part-I information.

Considering the above observations and facilities available, Medical Assessment and Rating Board has decided to issue Conditional permission to Kent Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital At & P.O. Khilwat (via-Bidapur Bazar) Hajipur, District Vaishali, Bihar for conducting UG (BHMS) Course with intake capacity of 50 seats for the academic year 2023-24.

The above shortfalls observed in your College shall be rectified within a period of 15 days and the compliance report shall be submitted to the MARBH, failing which the conditional permission issued will be withdrawn without further notice.

OPI and IPI guidance shall be as per the regulations and minimum number of 150 cases are to be registered in the OPI register per day being a UG Institute, and all cases shall be made

available in the medical records room for the academic purpose for students and follow up purpose for the patients.

It is highly essential that all cases registered in the Medical College be recorded with complete demographic details of the patients, essential contact details, postal address, and diagnosis as per ICD criteria of diseases.

For recording of OP case records, a short case recording proforma shall be followed. For the Community cases attended in the Hospital irrespective of OP or IP, detailed case recording format shall be followed with entire follow ups recorded on the case records. Cases attended in Community Health Care activities also shall be kept well documented for ongoing academic and follow up purposes.

All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be reserved as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/UT Govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT. The permission of the college shall be withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the central govt for All India quota of the students admitted thereunder.

The category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

2. As per provision of NCH Act, 2020 Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy (M&HBB) has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission for student intake to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform that Part-II Performa and all the relevant documents submitted by your college were examined as per the existing regulations.

3. On scrutiny and careful consideration of your documents and further observations of the Board, the following shortfalls to be addressed for granting permission for student intake in UG (BHMS) course for the academic year 2022-23:

I. HOSPITAL STAFF: Hospital catering staff is not available.

II. TEACHING FACULTY:

I. Dr. Shripa Rai, Assistant Professor (Pharmacy) is only BHMS, not MD.
II. Previous teaching experience of Dr. K.P. Roy (Professor- Materia Medica, their faculty), not provided.

III. WEBSITE: Research publication, details of CME & Conferences, Affiliations, University & Vice Chancellor, Result of last one year, clinical material in the Hospital are not updated on the college website- <http://kjhmc.in/>

IV. MISCELLANEOUS: College is required to submit the salary statement of all college and hospital staff from the concerned bank for the last academic year.

4. After considering the provisions of NCH Act, 2020 the conditional permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for continuing student intake is issued to Kent Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Khilwat, Bidhupur Bazar, Vaishali, Hajipur, Bihar-844503 for under graduate course (BHMS) with student intake capacity of 50 seats for the academic year 2022-23. The College Principal is directed to fulfill all deficiencies within a period of 3 months. An affidavit from Principal shall be submitted in this regard to MABHI within one week from the receipt of this letter.

5. All admissions in Under Graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The non-service of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under.
6. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed.

Sir,

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act-2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

"Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly, unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act".

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-I proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

2. On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has arrived at the following conclusion:-

That the applicant has set up a Homoeopathic Medical College with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take certain time bound steps to implement Minimum Standard Requirements of the Homoeopathy College and attached Hospital as prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy for conducting BHMS course in Homoeopathy and deficiencies are:

A. Discrepancies in engagement of teachers are as below :

- i. Dr.Chandeshwar Roy,Professor- Date of birth is 9.9.54, Age exceeding 67 years.
- ii. Dr. Vilay Kumar Pandey, Lecturer(MD 2017 Org)- Date of birth is 27.1.77 and date of joining is 1.9.17. Age exceeding 40 years at the time of joining as lecturer.

iii. Previous Full time teaching experience of Guest Reader/ Professor in the department of Anatomy, Physiology, Organon, Pharmacy, Materia Medica, Pathology, Forensic Medicine & Toxicology, Practice of Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynecologist, Community Medicine and Reperitory is not provided.

B. College Laboratories : Mummified bodies not available.

C. Miscellaneous :

- i. Salary bank statement not provided
- ii. PF/PF/ESI deduction of teachers, non teaching staff & hospital staff not deducted, chalan is also not submitted.
- iii. Form-16 of teachers, non teaching staff & hospital staff is not provided.

D. Website : <http://kumchhajipur.com> is functioning and IPD/OPD data is not updated as checked on dated 09/09/2021

3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, Permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is hereby granted to Kent Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Hajipur-844593, Bihar for continuing admissions in UG (BHMS) course with intake capacity of 50 seats during the academic year 2021-22. The College Principal is directed to fulfill the deficiencies within three months and an affidavit in this regard may be submitted to the Medical Assessment Board within a period of one week.

4. All admissions in Under Graduate and Post graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that minimum 12% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 88% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.

5. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

6. The college has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed and mentioned above which affects the performance of the academic institution, through which College fails to fulfill the statutory requirements, has to be rectified within three months time from the date of issue of this permission letter and the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly. 


