

Admission Guidelines

Following guidelines are framed for the entrance of students seeking admission in the Kent Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital.

Eligibility

10+2 / Intermediate Science or its equivalent with Physics, Chemistry and Biology is the basic requirement for admission. Student must have attained the age of 17 years as on 31st December of the year of admission. Candidates who have appeared in their qualifying examination and whose results are awaited may also apply, but they must submit the mark sheet and other certificates at the time of interview for final selection. Otherwise, the admission will not be considered.

There may be changes in eligibility rules by the NCH or State Government or University, which shall be applicable as per the prevailing regulations.

Total Number of Seats Available

50 (Fifty). Reservation of seats as applicable and provided under the regulation.

Submission of the Application

The application for admission must be made in the prescribed form available from the College Office. Only those applications which are complete in all respects will be entertained. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Application should be accompanied with attested photocopies of the following testimonials in three copies each:

- 3. Transfer certificate

- 7. Date of Birth proof certificate
- 8. Physical fitness certificate
- 9. Caste certificate (for SC/ST/OBC students)
- 10. Character Certificate from previous school
- 11. Migration certificate from students coming from other university
- 12. Five copies of recent passport size photograph
